South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I William Bright of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of two hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by George Mayfield of the said and district aforesaid have bargained granted sold and released and do by these presents bargain grant sell and release unto the said Mayfield all that tract or parcel of Land whereon I formerly lived containing seventy acres be the same more or less situated in the said and district aforesaid on the south side of Snow hole creek waters of South River it being bounded by the said creek on the north the County line of James Albert and John C. Brown on the east and John M. Brecken on the south and south west the said Land was conveyed to me by William Robt Jr and William Pasingame Sheriff to have and to hold all and singular the above premises the rights members and hereditaments thereto belonging unto myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend the above premises unto the said George Mayfield his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors and administrators and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 30 day of December AD 1835
