 of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen
 dollars to me in hand paid by Thomas Taylor of the State and District aforesaid
 have granted bargained sold and released and do by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said Thomas Taylor all that tract or parcel of Land
 situate in Greenville District and State aforesaid lying on the south side of
 Currier River containing fifteen acres more or less beginning in a white oak corner there
 with Thomas Taylor line to a black oak corner from thence a straight line to a black gum on the
 Bank of said River thence down the Meanders of said River to the beginning corner to gather
 with all and singular rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to said
 premises belonging or in anywise wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto said Thomas Taylor his
 heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singu-
 lar the said premises unto the said Thomas Taylor his heirs and assigns against
 myself my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming
 or to claim the same or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this the
 first day of October on thousand Eight hundred and Thirty six
