 his own use and behoof forever also one negro man named Toby with this express
 exception that the said negro man Toby is to remain my own right and
 property until after the death of both us and my wife Sarica after which period the
 said negro man Toby is to be his the said William West property absolutely
 and forever And I do hereby invest in the said William West his heirs and
 assigns forever all my right title interest claim or demand of in or to
 the above mentioned negroes with the above exception forever In
 witness of I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 16th day of January
 in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty seven and
 sixty first year of American Independence Signed sealed and delivered
