Newville District In the state aforesaid in consideration of the natural
love and affection which bear towards my son Henry
Brasher hath given and granted and by these presents doth grant unto the said
Henry Brasher his heirs and assigns all that tract of land whereon the said
Henry Brasher now lives being a tract of Land of one Hundred and Twenty three
Acres conveyed to me by Aquila Brasher on the 10th day of March 1800 having
such shapes and form as are further Represented in a deed which are now
in the possession of the said Henry Brasher which was given to me by Aquila
Brasher which a reserved right to the land and premises to my self Thomas
Brasher and Maniah Brasher during our natural life, and I do hereby
bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for
ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry
Brasher his heirs and assigns against all claims that now is and against
every person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 14th day of May 1866
and in the sixteenth year of the Independence of the united States of America
