Cor of the District of Greenville and state aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum
the of Three hundred and Twenty-five dollars to me in hand paid by Ayres Jones
of the District of Spartanburgh, and state aforesaid Have granted, bargained
all sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release
test unto the said Ayres Jones all that tract or parcel of land containing two
hundred acres be the same more or less, bounded as follows. Beginning on
a pine Cox on Kennedy's line, thence running N. 50 W. 28. to a black jack
Cox, thence S. 44. W. 38 to a Spanish Oak Cox thence along Jenkins line to a
green post oak Cox on Jesse P. Pool's line, thence to a large pine, thence on said line to a
large post oak Cox on Kennedy's line, thence on said line to a white oak Cox thence
back to the beginning. Together with all and singular the Rights, members heredita-
ments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
thereto or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Ayres Jones, his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby
bind myself, my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Ayres Jones
his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs and against every other person
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
after witness my hand thus to the day of February in the year of Our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and thirty four signed sealed and delivered X. in the
presence of H. J. Gillbreath Simon Styles. Isaac Chandler (Seal)
