 of the County of Richland and State of North Carolina do give
 bargain lease sell and convey unto M.S. Porter all that tract
 place or parcel of Land lying being and Situate in the
 State of South Carolina Greenville District on the waters of
 South Pacolet River it being part of a Tract of Land
 originally granted to William Clayton and bearing date 179
 beginning at a pine corner on Charles Whittier's Land thence
 running by an agreed line to Thomas Maxwells line a
 Stake corner thence with said line to agreed line turning to
 a pine corner thence to a Hickory thence to the beginning
 corner containing one hundred and fifty acres be the
 same more or less and all and every the appurtenances
 thereto belonging in in anywise appertaining to have
 and to hold unto the aforesaid M.S. Porter his heirs exec
 tors administrators or assigns forever against myself my
 heirs or any other person or persons or any part thereof in
 witness whereof I have affixed my hand and seal this
 the 10th day of November 1833
