

The estate of South Carolina.

I know all men by these presents that I number
 Jacob Green of the District of Greenville in the State of South Carolina
 Consideration by the sum of fourteen hundred Dollars to me paid by William Busbaine,
 in the said State have granted bargained, sold at
 released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said
 William Busbaine a certain tract of land or parcel of land situated in said
 District on both sides of the Spartanburgh road, about three miles from
 the town of Greenville on the Waters of Brushy Creek of Enoree River contain
 two hundred acres, being parts of two tracts of land, one owned
 formerly by Capt Isaac Green deceased, the other by Samuel Kelly deceased,
 the tract now to be conveyed hath such brand, marks &c as follows viz
 Beginning at a black gum 3x at the ford on Ruppels branch on the Spartanburgh road,
 thence up said road S. 58 W. 6.50 links to a small post Oak 3x thence
 along said road N. 74 E. 412.50 Chs to a stake 3x, thence having the road
 N. 49. W. 28.40 Chs to a stake 3x on a branch, thence S. 66. W. 20.50 Chs to a stake in
 a field thence E. 01. E. 15.60 Chs to a small dog wood 3x (John Green's corner)
 thence south 10.50 Chs to a stake in the old Longorce road thence down
 said road S. 10. E. 66 Chs to a bind in new road, thence S. 47 E. 3.50 Chs to a
 stake bend in said road, thence S. 60 E. 16. Chs to a bind, thence S. 34 E. 15 Chs to a
 bind, thence S. 34 E. 5.40 to a black Oak 3x thence N. 32 E. 11.25 to a dead
 post Oak 3x in a field thence N. 29 E. 23 Chs to a black gum 3x on said Ruppel's
 branch, thence down the branches of said branch to the beginning corner
 together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances
 belonging to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have and to
 hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Busbaine his
 heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs & executors to administer
 my estate to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William
 Busbaine, his heirs and assigns against myself, and my heirs and against every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 witness my hand and seal this day of in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and thirty seven and forty second year of the Independence of the United
 States of America. Jacob Green (Seal). Signed sealed and delivered
