 with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances  
 unto the said Allen Moore Jr. his heirs for ever, and I do hereby bind  
 myself, my heirs and Executors, to warrant and for ever defend the above  
 prescribed land for the use and purpose before mentioned unto  
 the said Allen Moore Jr. from me and my heirs, and every other person  
 or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or  
 any part thereof. As witness I have hereunto set my hand and affixed  
 my seal this 26<sup>th</sup> day of December, and in the year of Our Lord 1837.
