Snowall men by these presents,  
know that I S B Wallace of the District & State aforesaid, for and in consideration of  
the sum of the sum fifteen hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Nelson Gilbreath the  
Inhabitants of the District and state aforesaid have granted, bargained sold and released to  
me by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
Gilbreath all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred Acres to  
the same more or less, it being the upper part of a tract of land gra-  
nd to William Savage containing six hundred & eighteen acres, situate by  
and being as follows Viz in the District and state aforesaid on a branch of  
Conec River, and branches of Childers Bevadam creek a branch of  
South Tyger River, bounded by lines running N W by Hickland and  
Josephs lands & NE & E & SW by Styles land W by Kelley's land Known of that  
land by the name of cross planes where the District road crosses the Bantone-  
rake road References may be had to a deed from John Miller to John Wood  
and to all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres, more or  
less situate lying and being in the District and state aforesaid  
South adjoining the above mentioned one hundred acres of land references  
to conveyances and boundaries to a deed from Robert D Moore to Hartyme  
C. Gilbreath, also all the right title claim that I the said S B Wallace have  
ever a certain tract of parcel of land supposed to contain two hundred acres more or  
less situate lying and being in the District and state aforesaid on the Waters  
of Childers bevadam creek a water of South Tyger river, bounded by lands  
of the Wadsworth now occupied by Francis Edwards on the N. on the W by lands  
now owned by J. T. Wistmonland on the S. W. by lands of Samuel Styles on the E.  
the first one hundred acres of land above conveyed. Together with all the  
singular rights, Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, I do have  
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
Gilbreath his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself  
my heirs Executors & Administrators and assigns to warrant and forever  
keep all and singular (except the last mentioned two hundred acres of land)
