NOW know ye that I David Henning Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such cases made & provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of Thirty two dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said Andrew Bishop, the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Andrew Bishop his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances, and all the estate, right, title and interest, which the said Z Benson of right had, of in and to the same To have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land, with its appurtenances, unto the said Andrew Bishop his heirs and assigns forever as fully & absolutely as I the said David Henning might, could, or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri Facias, or otherwise.
