 said M. Bee recently sold two lots of Land one of the aforesaid

 off has included a small strip or slip of Land between the  
 mentioned lines and the said road which strip or slip of Land  
 was also conveyed by the aforesaid Edward Croft or his assigns to  
 the aforesaid Atwood and Gerard. Now this indenture witnesseth  
 that we the said C. B. Atwood Peter G. Gerard and Henry Earle  
 do hereby Relinquish to the Present town Council of the town  
 of Greenville and their successors favorable our interest  
 in or to the aforesaid strip or slip of Land viz from the  
 corner in the fork of the Buncombe road and the Avenue  
 to said M. Bee's residence South Eastward by down said  
 the said Piece of Land being all that lies Eastward of the above  
 named line bearing S. 35 1/2 E. as above stated Provided the aforesaid  
 strip or slip of Land remain forever as a public road or  
 and is not incumbered with any house or their nuisance  
 or hands and seal the day and year above written
