granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do grant,
 bargain sell and release unto the said James W. Clure a part
of a plantation or tract of land, lying and being in the State
and District aforesaid on Vanns Creek of North Sackett River, begin-
ning on a dogwood running thence across the creek N. 10 E. 1/2 ch^l
to a Hickory. Thence N. 60 W. 13 ch^l 50 lks to a Hickory. Thence N. 30
W. 10 ch^l 40 lks to a Hickory. Thence N. 56 W. 20 ch^l to a Black oak
thence N. 83 10 S. 14 ch^l to a Spanish Oak. thence S. to the road from
Mr Fisher to the creek. thence down S. creek. to a lane now
running through S^d plantation, thence with the direction of the
South end of S^d lane to the line of S^d tract of land. Thence
East on S^d line to the beginning dogwood. being a part of a
tract of land granted by patent bearing date August the 7th
1781 unto William Benson and by him conveyed to John
Reagan, and by S^d Reagan to me by deeds of conveyance bearing
