Sol. Softis } South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I
Guerrilla District, Solomon Dill of Guerrilla District and
State of Georgia in consideration of One Thousand Dollars to me paid by Solomon Softis
of the said District, I have bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the Solomon Softis a Plantation or Tract of land lying
in Guerrilla District on the Waters of Fox Creek of South Georgia beginning on a
Post oak corner that William J. Thomas made when he laid off One Thousand acres
of his tract, which is now in possession to John Page. The corner made to an old school
house since running so to a corner agreed on by me and Sol. Dill made by him
and Solomon Dill on a small oak not far from a branch since so 30 E 35.00
on a side slope part of the way to the back lying whar. The Mountain thence 65
to till it comes to John Page line thence along Page line to the beginning near
the school house containing by estimation Fifty more or less the same being part
of a tract of Land granted to Reuben Davis by A. Patton bearing date the fourth
day of December in the Year One thousand and Seven hundred & eighty six including
the Plantation where the said Solomon Softis now owns adjoining Land Survey for
Archable Dill together with all and Singular the rights wheresoever hereinafter
and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining
to have and to hold all and Singular the said premises before mentioned to the
said Solomon Softis his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself
my heirs and my Executors and administrators to warrant and defend the said
and Singular the said Premises unto the said Solomon Softis his heirs and assigns
against myself and heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming
or to claim or any part hereof in witness whereof the said Solomon Dill have
themselves set my hand and affixed my seal this tenth day of April one
