 To William Jacobs South Carolina Know all men by these
 Greenville District presents that S G
 McClanahan of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in
 consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Forty Two Dollars to
 me paid by William Jacobs of Greenville District in the State
 aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William
 Jacobs all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the
 District of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters of Brushy
 Creek, containing Seventy Two acres more or less adjoining lands
 of the said William Jacobs, George Williamson and others being the same
 that Dr Thomas B Williams sold to Felix Green and conveyed to me
 by David Henning late Sheriff of Greenville District by Deed dated
 the 26th day of February 1840, Together with all and singular the
 rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said pre-
 mises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have
 and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto
 the said William Jacobs his heirs and assigns forever, and I do
 hereby bind myself my Heirs executors and administrators to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said
 William Jacobs his heirs and assigns against me and my Heirs
 and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
 the same or any part thereof. Witness my Hand and seal this
 ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and forty and in the Sixty fifth year of the Independence of
 the United States of America, Signed sealed and delivered in
 presence of Sandy Walker, William Choice Jr. S.G. McClanahan Seal

 made oath he did see S.G. McClanahan sign seal and as his act and
 deed deliver'd the within deed for the uses and purposes therein mentioned
