I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Charles Garrison Two hundred and forty eight and a half acres situate and being in the District of Greenville being a part of the land purchased by Charles Garrison from Judge W Thompson. on Grove Creek adjoining lands of Samuel Williams and Garrisons other lands and whereas the said premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by William Jacobs of the District and State aforesaid for the sum of four hundred and ninety dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor. Now know ye that I William Mc Goodlett sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writs of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the statute in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of four hundred and ninety dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said William Jacobs, the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said William Jacobs his heirs and assigns forever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the said Charles Garrison of right had of in and to the same, To have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said William Jacobs his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said W Mc Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid and the said writs of fieri facias or otherwise, In witness whereof I the said William Mc Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid have hereunto set my hand and seal the fourth day of July in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty two
