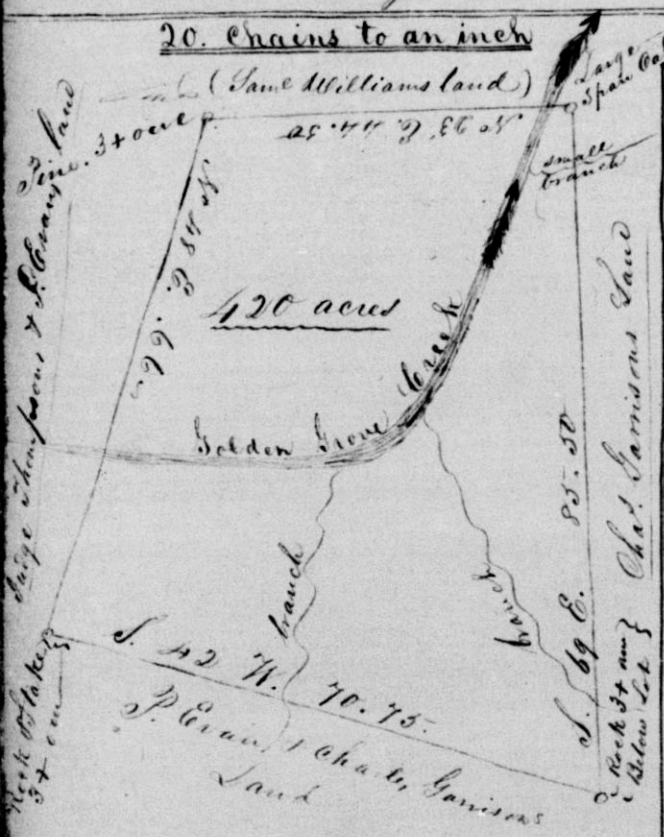

To all to whom these presents shall come, I, William M. Goodlett, Sheriff of Greenville District and State aforesaid, Greeting:

Whereas, by virtue of Summons writs of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville one tested the second day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred forty one at the suit of Williams Arr. to me directed commanding me that of the Goods & Chattles, lands & tenements of Charles Garrison, to levy the sum of one hundred fifty five & ⁴⁵/₁₀₀ Dollars damages costs, I have seized and taken of the lands & tenements of the said Charles Garrison all that certain piece, parcel & tract of land, containing more or less four hundred & twenty acres situate and being in the District

And Whereas the said premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writs of fieri facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public Auction & purchased by John C. Sullivan of the District & State aforesaid for the sum of seven hundred fifteen dollars being the highest sum that was bid for therefor, Now Know Ye, that I William M. Goodlett Sheriff, aforesaid by virtue of the said writs of fieri facias aforesaid to me directed & delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made & provided for & in consideration of the said sum of seven hundred fifteen Dollars to me in hand paid, or secured to be paid by the said John C. Sullivan the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said John C. Sullivan his heirs & assigns forever, the said tract piece or parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title & Interest which the said Charles Garrison of right had of in & to the same. To Have & To Hold the said piece parcel & tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said John C. Sullivan his heirs & assigns forever as fully & absolutely as I the said William M. Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid, might, could or ought to grant
