 To } Greenville District } presents that I, Moses Pritchett
 Elias Pritchett } of the State and District, aforesaid in consideration of the
 } sum of twenty five dollars to me in hand paid, by
 Elias Pritchett, of the District, and State aforesaid, have bargained and sold
 and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Elias
 Pritchett, a tract or parcel of land containing six acres, lying in the District
 of Greenville on the waters of Saluda River, beginning on a black Oak corner
 on Miss Sensons line, thence South East running along my line to a hickory
 corner on Celyan Clewards line, then North west to post Oak corner, thence
 along Sensons line South west, course to the beginning, corner, containing
 six acres be the same more or less. Together, with all and singular, the
 rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, be-
 longing or in any wise incident, or appertaining. To have and to hold, all
 and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Elias Pritchett
 his heirs and assigns forever. And I, do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors
 and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the
 premises before mentioned unto the said Elias Pritchett, his heirs & assigns
 against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons whomso-
 ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness
