State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I, Isaiak Cox, (Assignee) of W<sup>m</sup>. M. Alexander a Bankrupt) of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid

for and in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred and sixteen dollars secured to be paid to me, and the payment of which is hereby acknowledged, by Margaret Mackem of the District and State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Margaret Mackem, two tracts of land, lying and being in the district and state above mentioned on the waters of Brushy Creek of Reedy River, the said tracts having been purchased of N. M. Bee & Judge Thompson by said Alexander, the tract n<sup>o</sup> 1. or that purchased of N. M. Bee, containing eighty acres more or less, Beginning on a Spanish Oak corner, running thence n. 23 W. 90 to a Red oak corner, thence n. 70 E. 130 to a stake and pointer thence S. 26 E. 92 to a stake, thence S. 34 W. 70 to W<sup>m</sup> Jacobs line, thence with said Jacobs line n. 35 W. 5. to Judge Thompsons corner, thence n. 02 W. 41. to an old maple stump or root on Brushy Creek, thence along Judge Thompsons line 66 poles to the beginning, The tract n<sup>o</sup> 2 or that purchased of Judge Thompson containing forty eight & one fourth acre Beginning on a Stake corner at the ford of the creek, thence S. 36 E. 12. 80 to a Stake corner on W<sup>m</sup> Jacobs land, thence S. 63 W. 41. to the corner thence n. 40 W. 11 to a Black Oak, across the creek, thence by a white oak (Jacobs corner) to the Beginning, Together, with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident, or appertaining To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Margaret Mackem her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself (as assignee of said Alexander) to warrant and defend the said Margaret Mackem her heirs and assigns, all the right claim or interest that the said Alexander has or had in said tracts of land, Witness my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of January in the year of our Lord 1843, and in the 67<sup>th</sup> year of the American Independence Signed, Sealed and delivered in the
