O. thence N. 55. E. 35 Ch. to a N. O. thence S. 30. W. 12. Ch. to a Red oak, thence S. 50. West 35 Ch. to a Chestnut Stake thence the same course to the Beginning, containing two hundred acres more or less, together with all & singular the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances, to the premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appurtenanting. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John McClure, his heirs and assigns forever, against myself, my heirs & assigns and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors, or administrators to warrant, and forever defend, the said premises unto the said John McClure his heirs or assigns against myself, my heirs or assigns and against no other claim, as witness my hand and seal this 28th day of March 1835 -
