Ch. to a Stake Knob. Thence S. 26 E. 69 Ch. to a R. O. Thence S. 55. E.  
35' Ch. to a R. O. Thence S. 30 W. 12. Ch. to a Red oak. Thence S. 50'  
West 35' Ch. to a Chestnut Stake thru the same course to the begin-  
ning. Containing two hundred acres more or less, together with all &  
singular. the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances, to the said  
premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have  
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said John McClure, his heirs and assigns forever, against myself,  
myself my heirs & assigns and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs  
executors, or administrators to warrant and forever defend the said  
premises unto the said John McClure his heirs or assigns against

acres, be the same more or less, situated in the State & District  
aforesaid on Reedy River bounded S. E. on sd River E. by land  
belonging to said H. Sullivan & Edmund Ragsdale, & John Terry  
S. W. on the old Indian Boundary and sd Sullivan's Land shall  
such shape and form as laid down in a plat annexed to the  
original Grant. Together with all and singular the rights,
