Williamson, all that certain piece parcel and tract of Land containing more or less one hundred and sixty one acres situate and being in the District of Greenville (being all the portion of a tract wherein the Defendant resides containing more or less one hundred and seventy five acres that lies in Greenville District) on the District line between Santee and Greenville on the Augusta road adjoining land of James, Lovelace, Thomas Carter, G. Jamison et al - and where, the said premises with their appurtenances since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by Hensley Sullivan of the District Estates aforesaid for the sum of seven hundred & seven by Dollars being the highest sum that was bidden therefor. Now know ye. that I W. M. Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said writ of fieri facias aforesaid, to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of seven hundred and seventy dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Hensley Sullivan the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Hensley Sullivan his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract, piece or parcel of land, with its appurtenances, and all the estate right title and interest which the said John E. Williamson of right had of, in and to the same, To have and to hold, the said piece, parcel & tract of Land, with its appurtenances unto the said Hensley Sullivan, his heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as the said W. M. Goodlett Sheriff aforesaid, might or ought to grant, bargain and sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said writ of fieri facias or otherwise. In witness whereof I the said W.
