 do bargain sell and relinquish unto the said James McKinney
 a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid State,
 & District of Greenville and in Bartons Fork of Tyger River, bounded
 by lands belonging to Thomas Barton, James Goodlett,
 Wilson Goodlett, and Sarah McKinney, two hundred acres, more
 or less beginning on a pine corner, on the bank of Wilson Goodlett's ditch, running thence E. 46. C 37. C. to a B. O. thence 44.
 E. 54. Ch. 57. links to an ash tree 46. W. 37 Ch. to a Stake, thence
 N. 44 W. 54. Ch. 57. links to the beginning corner, which Land
 I do warrant & defend unto the said James McKinney, his
 heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs and assigns
 forever or any person or persons lawfully claiming the same
