Springfield of the state and District aforesaid hath given and granted and by these presents do freely give and grant unto the said Thomas B. Springfield, his heirs Executors or administrators a negro boy named Adam, aged about seven years of age of which before the signing of these presents I have delivered him the said Thomas B. Springfield an inventory signed with my own hand and even bearing date, To Have and To Hold the said Boy Adam, also a large family Bible to him the said Thomas B. Springfield his heirs, executors or administrators from henceforth as his property, Absolutely, In witness whereof I have put my hand Seal in presence of this 10th April A.D. 1843
