 land on which I now live containing 330 acres more or
 less bounded by Levy Newby Hanny Shelton and others
 for reference to deed from By A Carle to me, to
 have and to hold the said tract of land during his
 mother Polly Richards lifetime or whenever the said
 Hartwell P Richards and Robert P Richards both may
 see proper to divide said tract of land or sell and
 divide the proceeds they may do so. or when their mother
 dies then the said land to be divided between my son H S
 Richards and my son R J Richards or sell the said
 and divide the proceeds equal as they may see proper unto
 the said Hartwell P Richards and Robert P Richards to
 them and their heirs and assigns forever. I do hereby bind
 myself my heirs and executors to warrant and defend the
 said land unto the said Hartwell P Richards and Robert
 P Richards against myself or any other person claiming
 any part thereof to them and their heirs forever As witness
 my hand and seal this 4th November 1843
