thence to the beginning corner containing two hundred acres  
together with all and singular the rights membranes and  
appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise inci-  
dent Do have and to hold all the aforesaid premises unto the  
only use of the said Saml B Hill his heirs Exors or assigns for  
ever and I do hereby warrant and forever defend the same  
unto the same Saml B Hill his heirs Exors and Admsrs from  
my heirs Exors and Admsrs and from every person or persons
