

these presents that I, John McClure of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars to me paid by Delia Will of Spartanburgh District and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Delia Will all that tract of Land lying and being in the District of Greenville on both sides of Mill Creek a branch of South Pacolet River Beginning at a pine running thence N 40 W to a red oak thence S 50 W 27 chs to a Chestnut stake thence S 40 E to a small Pine (Emory Corner) thence to the beginning containing One hundred acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Delia Will his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the premises unto the said Delia Will his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 20th day of January 1843
