Deed for my upper Farm. The State of South Carolina, Greenville District.

Know all men by these presents that E. Edward Croft of the District and State aforesaid, for & in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand dollars to me in hand paid by Leroy H. Green of the District & State aforesaid, do herein and hereby bargain, sell release & convey unto the said Leroy H. Green his heirs and assigns forever, all & every the several Tracts of Land or parcels of Land, herein mentioned or intended to be mentioned & released, agreeable to the deeds of the same made to me & hereunto now delivered to the said Leroy H. Green to wit, two separate Tracts sold me from Pinckney Hawthorn's Jr one for two hundred and fifty acres of land the Title deed whereof is recorded on the 20 of January 1831 also one other Tract from said Pinckney Hawthorn's Jr containing One hundred and Eighty-five acres of Land, the Title deed whereof is recorded on the 1. day of January 1838. be the same more or less in within said - also one other tract from Joshua Hawthorn's containing one hundred & Eighty-five acres of Land, be the same more or less, the Title deed whereof is recorded on the 10<sup>th</sup> of April 1824 also one other Tract from Stephen Phillips containing Eighty-One acres of Land, be the same more or less; the Title deed whereof is recorded on the 17 of April 1824. also - Samuel Neely's agreement to sell 8 or 9 acres of Land, & the receipt of fifty dollars in full payment of the same, be the same more or less all these Tracts or parcels of Land are known by the name of my upper Farm - To have and to hold all & singular the premises together with all & singular the appurtenances & incidents thereto belonging or in any wise incident - and I the said Edward Croft, do hereby & herein bind myself & my heirs, Executors & Administrators, to warrant & forever defend all & singular the premises & every part thereof, from myself & my heirs, & also from all and every person or persons whatsoever claiming or to claim the same, in any part thereof, to the said Leroy H. Green his heirs & assigns forever. In witness whereof, I have hereunto put my hand & seal this 26 day of Aug<sup>t</sup> 1845.
