B. Purnocher do bind myself my heirs and assigns to H. B. Prince and his heirs and also do warrant and forever defend the sites & improvements and appurtenances to the sd premises and also bind myself my heirs Executors & Admors and also every other person whomsoever may lawfully claim the same in any part with-
out my hand and this January 15th 1845.
