 heirs Or assigns I warrant and forever defend all and singular
 law the s^d Premises unto the said Willis, A. J. Burroum, his heirs
 Or assigns.

 Or assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the
 said Premises Or Every Other Person or Persons lawfully claiming
 the same or any part thereof
