Now this Indenture witnesseth, that the said Josiah T. Pollard as well for and in consideration of the aforesaid debt or sum of one hundred and one dollar, eighteen and three fourth cents. unto the said William L. Pollard his Heirs, Executors, Administrators, or assigns in discharge of the said recited obligation a copy of which is herunto annexed, - and before the sealing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged - hath granted, bargained, sold, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth Grant, Bargain and sell unto the said William L. Pollard his heirs and assigns seventeen head of hogs, six head of cattle, one Cowd mare, three Beds of sheets, one Cullard, one chest, one Slab, one Table, and one Loom, to have and to hold unto the said William L. Pollard his heirs and assigns, Provided always nevertheless, that if the said Josiah T. Pollard, his heirs, Executors, or Administrators shall and do well and truly pay unto the said William L.
