and, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to me paid by George Washington Hopkins of Charleston in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, Do Grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said George Washington Hopkins One Hundred Acres of Land, being a portion of that Tract containing Four Hundred and Fifty Two Acres in all conveyed by John D. Lewis, to me, lying and being in Greenville district, and lying in Terry's Branch - Saw Creek, a branch of the West Fork of Saluda River, and hath such forms and marks and bounds as is represented by a Plat of John C. Hoyt, District Surveyor, made 3<sup>rd</sup> August, Eighteen Hundred and Thirty Seven, and attached to the Deed made by John A. Seland, Superintendent of Public Works, to John D. Lewis, and then transferred by him to me - Said Land being bounded on the North by lands now or late, the property of Aaron Templeman, on the East by a portion of said Tract, now the property of George Allison, on the South West by lands of McKinney and Jack Phillips, and on the West West, by lands now the property of the said Michael Mr. Bride, said boundaries being in accordance with the aforesaid Plat which is annexed to the original Title Deed.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances, to the said Premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining.
