and eight hundred and forty four between John Watson ordinary of the
District aforesaid, and Ailsey Hollyclaw of the same state and dis-
trict. Whereas a writ of summons to divide or sell a certain tract
of land, hereinafter described of the estate of Stephen Hollyclaw
deceased, issued from the Court of Ordinary of said district, and
upon the return thereof, the judge of said Court, did deter-
mine that the said land could not be divided without injury
to the interests of the parties, and did order the same to be
sold by the Sheriff of the district aforesaid on a credit of twelve
months. Whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the said
land for sale on the first Monday in February of the present year.
And whereas the Sheriff aforesaid, did on the said day, expose to
sale at public outcry, on the credit aforesaid the said land when
the said Ailsey Hollyclaw was the last and highest bidder, to whom
the said land was struck off for the sum of four hundred dollars.

Now this indenture witnesseth that in con-
sideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to me paid, I
have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Ailsey Hollyclaw, her heirs and assigns forever, all that part
of the aforesaid tract of land, designated as Lot No. 3 sit-
uate in said district, on the waters of Enoree River and
on both sides of the State road, containing ninety two acres
(more or less) and hath the such bounds, marks &c as follows,
beginning at a Rock 3 x thence N. 72 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 35. 50 chs to a span-
ish oak bush 3 x thence N. 25 W. 16. 50 chs to a stalle 3 x thence
N. 60 W. 19. 50 chs to a spanish oak 3 x thence S. 45 W. 7. 50 chs.
to a Post Oak 3 x thence N. 60 W. 11 chs. to a Hickory 3 x thence S.
4 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 27. 75 chs to a Spanish oak 3 x thence S. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 10 chs to
