and state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to me in hand paid by Samuel McClanahan of the same district and State I have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell to the said Samuel McClanahan all that part of my tract of land, which I purchased of Col. William Finney and John Robertson, lying on the East side of the road called the white Horse road, from Spencers line down the road to Col<sup>l</sup> George Flemings line, containing ten acres more or less. To have and to hold, said tract of land, together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the said Samuel McClanahan his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend the said premises to the said Samuel McClanahan his heirs and assigns against the claims of myself my heirs and all others lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
