Jones a certain Tract or parcel of land wherein the said Jones now lives containing one hundred and sixty three acres be the same more or less situate in the District and state aforesaid on the East and middle forks of Laurel Creek waters of Ready run Beginning on a stone 3 x (corner of Tilman Millers Lands running thence S. 60 W. 17.40 chains to a post oak 3 x 3 x the E 30 E. 63.50 chains to a post oak 3 x 3 x thence N. 61 E. 72.50 links across the middle & East forks of Laurel Creek to a small oak 3 x 3 x on a branch thence N. 30 W. 11.50 to a stone 3 x thence S. 60 W. 55 chains to a stone 3 x thence N. 30 W. 56 chains to the beginning reference to a plat made by Thomas P.
