

Together with all and singular the Hereditaments, rights, members and appurtenances whatsoever, to the said Tract of Land, belonging, or in any wise appertaining; and the reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, donor, possession, property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both at Law and in Equity, of the heirs and representatives of the said John Hightower and of all the parties to this suit, and of all other persons rightfully claiming, or to claim the same, in any part thereof, by, from, or under them, or either of them: To Have and to Hold the said Tract of Land with its Hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances, unto the said Alfred Cantrell his heirs and assigns, to him and his only proper use, behoof, for ever.
