


and condition, that whatever portion of said Interest may not be necessarily appropriated to the maintenance of said Emma Helen Green and to the maintenance & education of said Issue, shall be made capital or principal, and be put and kept at Interest in the same manner and for the same uses and purposes with the aforesaid principal or capital sum; and upon this further Trust and condition that if the said Emma Helen Green should die without leaving Issue of her body by said marriage living at the time of her death, or if she should leave such Issue living at the time of her death but afterwards all of such Issue should die before attaining the age of twenty one years and before marrying, then and in that case I do Trust that said Daniel Statham shall hold the said capital sum and all Interest due thereupon for the use and benefit of the said George W. Green his heirs and assigns forever, and shall execute said Trusts by transferring assigning and conveying the same to the said George W. Green his heirs or assigns forever; and upon this further Trust and condition that the said Daniel Statham shall at his discretion and with the consent of said George W. Green and Emma Helen Green signified in writing under their hand have power and authority to invest any portion of said funds in Bank Stock, or other property, subject to the same Trusts conditions and limitations as are herein before expressed & declared this 21st October 1846.
