


Oak in old field; thence S. 1 W. 84.50 chs. to a large Red Oak; thence S. 89 E. 40 chs. to a stake on the Wilson's ferry Road; thence up said road to the beginning Stake, (excepting sixteen & 1/2 acres sold to Lawrence Lynhardt as marked on original plat) bounded by the Lands of Mrs. Rich^d. Gault, Joshua Thompson, Lawrence Lynhardt, & John Markley, it being a part of the Tract of Land conveyed to Rich^d. Gault by Dr^r Rich^d. Harrison & by the said Rich^d. Gault to Edw^d. Gault & Susannah Gault, w the survivor of them, & by the sd. Edw^d. Gault to J. J. Gault & W. J. Gault in Trust for Sarah Gault as by reference to sd Deed will more fully appear, & by J. J. Gault, W. J. Gault, Rich^d. Gault, Sarah Gault, & Edw^d. Gault to me, having such metes and bounds as above described, & contained in said plat, as surveyed by John Watson September 13th 1842.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, w in anywise incident w appertaining: To have and to hold, all and singular the Premises before mentioned, unto the said Lawrence Brock his Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said Premises, unto the said Lawrence Brock his Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming, w to claim the same, w any part thereof.

Witness my Hand and Seal, this second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty six, and in the twenty first year of the Independence of the United States of America.


