Lynch all that Piece, parcel or Tract of Land, with the Buildings and Improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid, measuring and containing Seven Acres - two Rods and twenty nine poles and lying near the Village of Greenville on the North side of the Bancombe Road, being the same that Peter G. Gerard, conveyed to George Patton and refund to in a Plat of John Watson, Surveyor dated 24th August 1833, annexed to the Deed from G. Croft to P. G. Gerard and sold under a foreclosure of mortgage by D. Hoke Sheriff of said District, to the said George Buist on the fifth day of June eighteen hundred and forty five.
