covenant to and with the said Robert McRay, his heirs,  
executors, administrators, and assigns, to indemnify, assure  
and save them harmless forever against the right, and claim  
of my wife Mary A. Smoyer, to dower of or and to all  
and singular the lot of land aforesaid.
