he directed his Executor to sell for distribution among his Heirs &c. Now Know all men by these presents that I James T. Loveloff Executor of James Loveloff Deed in consideration of Seven Hundred and Twenty dollars to me paid by Joseph Sullivan of Laurens District & State aforesaid, have granted, bargained sold and released and by these presents do bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph Sullivan a plantation or tract of land containing Two Hundred fifty acres (more or less) situate in Greenville District, lying on the branches of Horse Creek waters of Reedy River beginning at a Red Oak Tree binding on Martin Arnold's land running thence N. 39° W 37.50' to a Red Oak Tree thence S 48° W 65.30' to a Sassafras Tree binding on Joseph McCullough's land, thence S 40° E. 44.00' binding on Elizabeth Gains lands to a Stake Tree on a Branch, thence down the meanders of said Branch to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph Sullivan his Heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Execs and Admrs to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph Sullivan his Heirs and assigns against myself & against my Heirs and assigns every other Person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
