E. Waddills part is bound- ed by the following Tracts of land South by Rock Irvine on the East by Thomas McCarter and Turpins land on the North by Rock R. Croft and West by Mrs. E. Houghes which lands I this day convey to the said Solbert E. Waddill from me and my heirs and from every other person to have and to hold the same Lands Tenement & Hereditaments to him and his heirs for- ever - and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administra- tors or assigns to warrant and forever defend the same to them for ever - in witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal This sixth day of December Eighteen Hundred and Forty Seven.
