presents bargain sell release and convey for the sum of
Five Hundred Dollars good and lawful money of this
State unto Solbert E. Waddill all my right title and in-
terest in the tract of land whereon I now live it being the
tract of which Elaben Waddill Deceased died, seized
and possessed one third of which I held another third
I purchased of James Witzarten all of which I hereby
convey and which including T. E. Waddills part is bound-
ed by the following Tracts of land South by Pock Swine
on the East by Thomas McCarter and Turpins land on the
North by Pock R. Croft and West by Mrs. E. Hughes
which lands I this day convey to the said Solbert E. Waddill from
me and my heirs and from every other persons to have and to hold
the same Lands Tenement & Hereditaments to him and his heirs for-
ever - and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administra-
tors or assigns to warrant and forever defend the same to him for-
ever - in witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal. This
sixth day of December Eighteen Hundred and forty seven.
