Bolling of the Town of Greenville in the State aforsaid have granted, Bargained, Sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, Bargain, sell and release, unto the said Mrs. Mary A. Bolling a certain Lot of Land lying in the North east square of the Town of Greenville, known and distinguished on the plan of said Town by its N^o. being 42. Beginning at a stake on Washington Street and runs thence South 34 E. 300 feet along Washington Street to a stake on Stone, thence S. 16 W. 170 feet to a stake, thence N. 74 W. along a line of Lot No. 43 to a stake on McBee Street, thence along said last mentioned street N^o 16 E. 170 feet to the Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members, Predicaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or apper- taining, to have and to hold, all and singular the premises be- fore mentioned, unto the said Mrs. Mary A. Bolling her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, ex- ecutors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises, unto the said Mrs. Mary A. Bolling the heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and every oth- er person or persons lawfully claiming a to claim the same or any part thereof.
