

Know all men by these pres-  
 ents that I Jefferson Choice  
 of the Town of Greenville in the  
 aforesaid State and District of Greenville in consideration of Two  
 thousand and five hundred Dollars to me paid by Mrs. Mary  
 M. Bolling of the Town of Greenville in the State aforesaid have  
 granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents,  
 do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Mrs. Mary  
 M. Bolling a certain Lot of Land lying in the North east square  
 of the Town of Greenville, known and distinguished in the plan  
 of said Town by its No. being #2. Beginning at a stake on  
 Washington Street and runs thence South 74 E. 300 feet along  
 Washington Street to a stake on Stone, thence S. 16 W. 170 feet  
 to a stake, thence N. 74 W. along a line of Lot No. #3 to a  
 stake on McPeck Street, thence along said last mentioned Street  
 N. 16 E. 170 feet to the Beginning Together with all and sin-  
 gular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to  
 the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or apper-  
 taining, to have and to hold, all and singular the premises be-  
 fore mentioned, unto the said Mrs. Mary M. Bolling her heirs  
 and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, ex-  
 cutors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and  
 singular the said premises, unto the said Mrs. Mary M. Bolling  
 her heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and every oth-  
 er person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or  
 any part thereof.
