 to a Stake 3x Thence N 76 1/4 E. 34, 60 to the beginning corner Bounded
 by lands belonging to H. Cooley and David Vincent

 incidents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise
 incident or appurtenant To Have and to Hold all and singular the premises
