Burns widow Elizabeth Burns, Edward Powell

In Powell his wife of the State and District aforesaid heirs
at law of Jeremiah Burns deceased late of Grenville District in the State aforesaid

consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to us paid by Claudia Burns and also in con-
sideration of the sum of One hundred and fourteen Dollars to Edward Powell paid by Claudia
Burns, and also in pursuant of and agreement between the said parties to divide and partition
between them the lands of the said Jeremiah Burns deceased late of the District in the State aforesaid
we have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain
sell and release, unto the said Claudia Burns All that piece, part and tract of land lying
in said District on the Head waters of Enore River, adjoining lands of Benjamin Bellings
James Johnson, Matthew Carter and Sarah Burns, being comprised of that portion of the land
belonging to Jeremiah Burns deceased which has been agreed to be partitioned and set off
to the said Claudia Burns as her share, and including fifty seven acres of that portion
of said land which has been set off to the said Edward and Matthew Powell as their
share and which is herein and hereby conveyed to the said Claudia Burns.

The whole of the tract hereby conveyed containing One hundred
and Thirteen Acres more or less and to be bounded and bottered according to the plan of a
Survey hereafter to be made.

Together, with all and singular the Rights, Members, Heredi-
taments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
To them and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Clau-
dia Burns her Heir and Assign forever. And we do hereby bind ourselves our Heirs
Exequators and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said
Premises unto the said Claudia Burns her Heir and Assign, against us and our Heirs
and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming to claim the same or any part thereof.
