 Harriet a young negro woman and her child Harriet, Charney and her child
 William and Ben a negro man To have and to hold the said negroes after
 my death in trust with their increase for the sole use and benefit of the
 said Sally Sullivan during her natural life and after her death for the use
 and benefit of her children their heirs and assigns without limitation
