

William Morgan Mortgage State of South Carolina Known  
To Greenville District all men  
by these presents that whereas William  
Morgan of the District and State aforesaid

stand justly indebted to William A. Mooney of the same State and District on the  
first sum and full sum of fifty Six Dollars and cents of note of hand as  
follows viz

On or before the first day of March 1849 I promise to pay W.  
A. Mooney or bearer Fifty Six Dollars for value received witness my hand  
and seal Mar. 7<sup>th</sup> 1848 Wm Morgan Seal

And for the better securing the payment of the same I have this day mortgo-  
ged with the said Mooney the following property viz 1 Black mare Three  
Cows and 1 Yearling 1 Team Five Pairs of heavy chains and one Large  
Hitch. The other said Mooney being the legal owner of the same but I reserving  
to myself the use of the property above named until the under written conditions  
are complied with conditioned that I am not to sell Trade or dispose of  
in any way any portion of the same

Now the conditions of the above obligation  
is such that if I the said William Morgan pay or cause to be paid  
onto the Wm A. Mooney the amount above mentioned on or before the first day  
January 1<sup>st</sup> A. D. 1850 then this obligation to be null and void otherwise to  
remain in full force and virtue Given under my hand and seal This seventeenth  
day of December A.D. 1848. Signed }  
Sealed in the presence of Elias Holcombe } Wm Morgan Seal

Greenville District me the subscribing magistrate and made  
oath that he did see William Morgan sign seal and deliver the within  
Mortgage for the uses and purposes therein contained
