all the Estate right title interest property claim and demand whatsoever either in law or equity
which we the said William and Matilda Smith hath or have in to or upon all and singular
a certain lot a piece of Land situated lying and being in Greenville District and State
aforesaid Together with all and singular the House Woods Water ways pinnacles
and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise pertaining to have and to hold all
and singular above mentioned and described lot a piece of land situated lying and being
as aforesaid Together and singular the House Woods Water ways and pinnacles thereto
belonging or in any wise appertaining unto them the said Trustees and their successors
in office forever in Trust that they shall have the same a place of worship for the use
of the members of the Methodist Episcopal Church according to the rules and discipline
which from time to time may be agreed upon and adopted by the ministers and
preachers of the said Church and the said Trustees doth by these presents warrant
and defend all and singular the before mentioned and described lot a piece
of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto them the said Trustees
and their successors ever and appurtenant by the preacher in charge from the claim a
claim of him the said Smith has been and appears a full claim a claim
of all persons whatever in Testimony whereof the said William and Matilda
