Dollars to me paid by Mary Henson and Sarah  
Dill in the District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and  
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Mary  
Henson and Sarah Dill all that tract of Land containing One Hundred and fifty  
moo Acres, more or less. Situated in Greenville District on Bank of Tyger  
River Beginning at a Red Oak. Ebenezer and Rebecca Barnett came Thence  
S 80 E 43 ch 50 links to Red Oak said Henson came Thence W 4 ch 65 S to pine  
Stump Thence S 80 E 21 ch 50 S. Chestnut John Henson came Thence W 12 E  
30 ch. to Hickory on the Bank of the River Thence up said River as it meanders  
to Ash Daniel Henson came Thence W 52 44 9 ch to a Red Oak Thence  
W 6 E 15 ch to Red oak Thence W 82 44 14 ch 40 S to a Rock Thence S 60  
S to Rock Thence W 4 ch to a small Branch Thence down the Branch  
to the Creek Thence S 15 W to a Red oak near a small branch Ebony and  
Mary Mc Barnett came Thence up said branch as it meanders to the Head  
of a straight line to the beginning being a part of two Tracts of land  
granted to Thomas Person the other to Allen Gwin. Together with all and  
singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances belonging to  
the same or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto.

I do now and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said Mary Henson and Sarah Dill their heirs and  
assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators  
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto  
the said Mary Henson and Sarah Dill their heirs and assigns against my  
self my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof.
